COVID-19 Joint Select Committee Draft Motion

- 1. Noting the significant impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the lives of Tasmanians, and the emergency response by the Tasmanian Government including coronavirus-related expenditure, legislative and public policy developments, it is resolved that a Joint Select Committee be appointed with power to inquire into and report upon:
 - (a) the State's immediate and ongoing COVID-19 response and recovery measures;
 - (b) the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the health, economic and social lives of Tasmanians; and
 - (c) any other matter incidental thereto.
- 2. The number of Members to serve on the said Committee on the part of the Legislative Council be four.

(The number of Members to serve on the said Committee on the part of the House be four, being: one nominated by the Leader of the Government; one nominated by the Leader of the Opposition; one nominated by the Leader of Tasmanian Greens; and one further member.)
