(7) When comparing an individual to one or more evidence DNA profiles, there are generally two competing possibilities (known as hypotheses, H1 and H2) to explain the observed DNA profile(s)

- H1: A person of interest (POI) is the source of, or a contributor to, the DNA obtained.
- H2: The POI is not the source of, or contributor to, the DNA but rather it was left by an unknown person(s)

The hypothesis that is the most favoured of the two possibilities considered is shown in bold.

The *likelihood ratio* can be expressed as "**The DNA profile(s) obtained from the sample is approximately X times more likely to have been obtained if the people designated in the bold (most supported) hypothesis are the sources of DNA rather than the people designated in the other hypothesis**". If the value of 'X' in the above statement is equal to or greater than 100 billion the value of '100 billion' will be used. Given alternative scenarios, it is possible to calculate additional *likelihood ratios*

Glossary

NB. Test methods used routinely at FSST are widely used and accepted in the forensic community. Numbers in square brackets, below, are references to the appropriate method in Forensic Biology. If terms specific to Bloodstain Pattern Analysis or Textile Damage are used in this report they will appear in a separate section at the end of the Glossary.

Biological examination

Information appearing in the "Scientific Opinion" column of the report is based upon the opinions/conclusions formed by the reporting Biological Examiner. The following terms are employed to express these opinions:-

Not detected – tested for and negative result obtained.

Detected – positive *confirmatory test*.

Inconclusive – weak *screening test* result.

Possible – one or more positive *screening test* results which may indicate the presence of a certain biological material.

Other definitions:

Alternate light source - A light source of a wavelength (colour) that causes physiological fluids such as saliva, semen and blood to fluoresce or absorb the light to enable the location of such substances to be detected. This technique is a *screening test* only.

Confirmatory test – Used to positively confirm the presence of a particular substance. Confirmatory tests are specific to the substance being tested but not necessarily very sensitive. The failure to confirm the presence of a biological fluid does not preclude that it is present but not detectable.

Human blood – Positive with a *confirmatory test* for human blood [BM27]. This test can also detect blood from monkeys, apes and ferrets. A positive result is reported as human blood on the assumption that blood from these animals is not present. If it is suspected that such blood may be present FSST should be contacted so that further testing can be undertaken.

Luminol – *screening test* for blood.

Nucleated squamous epithelial cells – Large, flattened cells forming the exposed layer of the membrane lining some body surfaces. In the forensic context they are most commonly found originating from the mouth and vagina, but are also found in the rectum, cornea, oesophagus and distal part of the urethra.

Screening test – Used to locate a substance and/or select a substance for further testing. Screening tests are very sensitive, but not necessarily specific, to the substance being tested.

screening tests for blood – hemastix [BM06], luminol [BM05]

screening tests for semen - acid phosphatase [BM12], *alternate light source* [BM14]

screening tests for saliva – amylase [BM16], presence of nucleated squamous epithelial cells [BM15]

screening test for faeces – urobilin [BM17]

Semen – Semen consists of seminal fluid that usually contains **sperm** (absent in vasectomised males).

Sperm – Abbreviation of **spermatozoon** (singular) and **spermatozoa** – the reproductive cell(s) of a male. For the purposes of this report the finding of sperm is considered a *confirmatory test* for semen [BM15].

Low number of sperm - A low number of sperm can be due to factors such as low production in some males, loss through the passage of time, or the transfer from another semen stained item such as through washing.

Assumed contributor – for the purposes of statistical calculation the DNA of this person is assumed to be present in this profile [DNA 20].

Excluded – An individual is said to be 'excluded' as a contributor to a DNA profile if components (alleles) in their reference DNA profile do not appear in the evidence DNA profile and this absence cannot reasonably be explained [DNA 21].

FTA - Specialised paper for the long term storage of DNA samples [DNA 02A] [DNA16].

Likelihood Ratio - A statistical approach for comparing two competing hypotheses. The result obtained indicates which hypothesis is more likely to explain the observed profile [DNA 20].

M and F fraction – Samples that are thought to contain human *semen* are differentially extracted to separate *sperm* away from other cellular material. The fraction expected to contain most of the intact *sperm* cells is designated "M" and the fraction containing the remaining DNA is designated "F". In the case of intimate samples such as underwear or swabs from a person, most of the DNA in the F fraction is expected to have come from the person from whom the item was taken. Incomplete separation may occur, resulting in *mixed* DNA profiles in one or both fractions [DNA 02A].

Major/Minor – a *mixed* profile can sometimes be separated into its component parts. The major profile is the DNA contribution believed to be from one or more individuals that is present at a level approximately 3 times or greater than that of DNA from other minor contributor/s [DNA11A] [DNA 21].

Male specific DNA test – This form of testing will only return a result relating to the male DNA that is present in a sample. This may be particularly useful in cases where there is a large amount of DNA from one or many females, and only a small amount of DNA from any male contributors. Due to the way in which this male specific DNA is inherited, all males in a paternal line (eg brothers, father and sons) are likely to share the same male specific DNA profile. This means that a male specific profile is not as rare as a standard DNA profile [DNA18].

Mixture/mixed profile – A profile containing DNA from more than one individual. Where information below the reporting level is used to determine that the profile is a mixture the term **apparent mixture** is used [DNA11A] [DNA 20] [DNA 21] [DNA 22].

Not analysed – When there are complicating factors that mean the number of contributors is uncertain (and the different options would lead to dramatically different likelihood ratios) then a DNA profile will not be analysed. Alternatively, if a DNA profile is not of probative interest it may not be analysed [DNA 20].

Not calculated – A statistical weighting has not been calculated because the result provides no probative information (e.g. the DNA profile obtained from a hand swab matches the reference profile of that individual) or statistical weightings have been provided for other results that have more probative value. In these instances the term 'not calculated' is used, and a statistical weighting can be calculated if requested [DNA 20].

No reliable conclusions – If a DNA profile (or an interpreted component of a mixed DNA profile) is too complex, weak and/or incomplete to either exclude or not exclude an individual, then it is considered unreliable for determining whether that individual has contributed DNA to the sample [DNA 20].

Single source component – the portion of a mixed DNA profile that can be attributed to a single individual [DNA 21] [DNA 22].

- H1: A person of interest (POI) is the source of, or a contributor to, the DNA obtained.
 - H2: The POI is not the source of, or contributor to, the DNA but rather it was left by an unknown person(s)
- The hypothesis that is the most favoured of the two possibilities considered is shown in bold.
- The *likelihood ratio* can be expressed as "**The DNA profile(s) obtained from the sample is approximately X times more likely to have been obtained if the people designated in the bold (most supported) hypothesis are the sources of DNA rather than the people designated in the other hypothesis**". If the value of 'X' in the above statement is equal to or greater than 100 billion the value of '100 billion' will be used. Given alternative scenarios, it is possible to calculate additional *likelihood ratios*
- (8) *Likelihood ratio* results have been included in the table of DNA results, where appropriate.

Glossary

NB. Test methods used routinely at FSST are widely used and accepted in the forensic community. Numbers in square brackets, below, are references to the appropriate method in Forensic Biology. If terms specific to Bloodstain Pattern Analysis or Textile Damage are used in this report they will appear in a separate section at the end of the Glossary.

Biological examination

Information appearing in the "Scientific Opinion" column of the report is based upon the opinions/conclusions formed by the reporting Biological Examiner. The following terms are employed to express these opinions:-

Not detected – tested for and negative result obtained.

Detected – positive *confirmatory test*.

Inconclusive – weak *screening test* result.

Possible – one or more positive *screening test* results which may indicate the presence of a certain biological material.

Other definitions:

Alternate light source - A light source of a wavelength (colour) that causes physiological fluids such as saliva, semen and blood to fluoresce or absorb the light to enable the location of such substances to be detected. This technique is a *screening test* only.

Confirmatory test – Used to positively confirm the presence of a particular substance. Confirmatory tests are specific to the substance being tested but not necessarily very sensitive. The failure to confirm the presence of a biological fluid does not preclude that it is present but not detectable.

Human blood – Positive with a *confirmatory test* for human blood [BM27]. This test can also detect blood from monkeys, apes and ferrets. A positive result is reported as human blood on the assumption that blood from these animals is not present. If it is suspected that such blood may be present FSST should be contacted so that further testing can be undertaken.

Luminol – *screening test* for blood.

Nucleated squamous epithelial cells – Large, flattened cells forming the exposed layer of the membrane lining some body surfaces. In the forensic context they are most commonly found originating from the mouth and vagina, but are also found in the rectum, cornea, oesophagus and distal part of the urethra.

Screening test – Used to locate a substance and/or select a substance for further testing. Screening tests are very sensitive, but not necessarily specific, to the substance being tested.

screening tests for blood – hemastix [BM06], luminol [BM05]

screening tests for semen - acid phosphatase [BM12], *alternate light source* [BM14]

screening tests for saliva – amylase [BM16], presence of nucleated squamous epithelial cells [BM15]

screening test for faeces – urobilin [BM17]

Semen – Semen consists of seminal fluid that usually contains **sperm** (absent in vasectomised males).

Sperm – Abbreviation of **spermatozoon** (singular) and **spermatozoa** – the reproductive cell(s) of a male. For the purposes of this report the finding of sperm is considered a *confirmatory test* for semen [BM15].

Low number of sperm - A low number of sperm can be due to factors such as low production in some males, loss through the passage of time, or the transfer from another semen stained item such as through washing.

DNA

Assumed contributor – for the purposes of statistical calculation the DNA of this person is assumed to be present in this profile [DNA 20].

Excluded – An individual is said to be ‘excluded’ as a contributor to a DNA profile if components (alleles) in their reference DNA profile do not appear in the evidence DNA profile and this absence cannot reasonably be explained [DNA 21].

FTA - Specialised paper for the long term storage of DNA samples [DNA 02A] [DNA16].

Likelihood Ratio - A statistical approach for comparing two competing hypotheses. The result obtained indicates which hypothesis is more likely to explain the observed profile [DNA 20].

M and F fraction – Samples that are thought to contain human *semen* are differentially extracted to separate *sperm* away from other cellular material. The fraction expected to contain most of the intact *sperm* cells is designated “M” and the fraction containing the remaining DNA is designated “F”. In the case of intimate samples such as underwear or swabs from a person, most of the DNA in the F fraction is expected to have come from the person from whom the item was taken. Incomplete separation may occur, resulting in *mixed* DNA profiles in one or both fractions [DNA 02A].

Major/Minor – a *mixed* profile can sometimes be separated into its component parts. The major profile is the DNA contribution believed to be from one or more individuals that is present at a level approximately 3 times or greater than that of DNA from other minor contributor/s [DNA11A] [DNA 21].

Male specific DNA test – This form of testing will only return a result relating to the male DNA that is present in a sample. This may be particularly useful in cases where there is a large amount of DNA from one or many females, and only a small amount of DNA from any male contributors. Due to the way in which this male specific DNA is inherited, all males in a paternal line (eg brothers, father and sons) are likely to share the same male specific DNA profile. This means that a male specific profile is not as rare as a standard DNA profile [DNA18].

Mixture/mixed profile – A profile containing DNA from more than one individual. Where information below the reporting level is used to determine that the profile is a mixture the term **apparent mixture** is used [DNA11A] [DNA 20] [DNA 21] [DNA 22].

Not analysed – When there are complicating factors that mean the number of contributors is uncertain (and the different options would lead to dramatically different likelihood ratios) then a DNA profile will not be analysed. Alternatively, if a DNA profile is not of probative interest it may not be analysed [DNA 20].

Not calculated – A statistical weighting has not been calculated because the result provides no probative information (e.g. the DNA profile obtained from a hand swab matches the reference profile of that individual) or statistical weightings have been provided for other results that have more probative value. In these instances the term ‘not calculated’ is used, and a statistical weighting can be calculated if requested [DNA 20].

No reliable conclusions – If a DNA profile (or an interpreted component of a mixed DNA profile) is too complex, weak and/or incomplete to either exclude or not exclude an individual, then it is considered unreliable for determining whether that individual has contributed DNA to the sample [DNA 20].

Single source component – the portion of a mixed DNA profile that can be attributed to a single individual [DNA 21] [DNA 22].
